**Pastor: Rev. Anthony Alphonse ~ Diocese of Austin**

*A Gospel reflection from Fr. Alphonse:*

*Today we celebrate the feast of Pentecost. On Pentecost day the Spirit of God descended on the Apostles, and they set forth to build a new community, the community of the new people of God. They spoke a new language. It was the language of love and cooperation, a language all of good will and understanding. For love transcends speech. It shines in the face and is felt in the clasp of a hand. Hence, it can unite people of different languages.*

Today is the birthday of this great happening. It is the birthday of the Church, the community of the followers of Jesus. On this day the infant Church left the cradle and took its first steps, not faltering but boldly, thanks to the power of the Holy Spirit. God knows, down the ages, the Church has seen its fair share of troubles, problems, setbacks. But it is still being built.

When we assemble in the church, it is something marvelous. Not that it is made up of Saints. It is, rather, like the field Jesus spoke about – a mixture of wheat and weeds. When we assemble here we do so, not as rivals, but as friends. We realize that before God we are all equal.

St. Paul reminds us that we are the temples of the Holy Spirit. That means that we have to manifest the presence of the Spirit of God in our life: *Joy, Purity, Peace and Unity.*

*Come, Holy Spirit, fill the hearts of the faithful and kindle in them the fire of your love.*
