

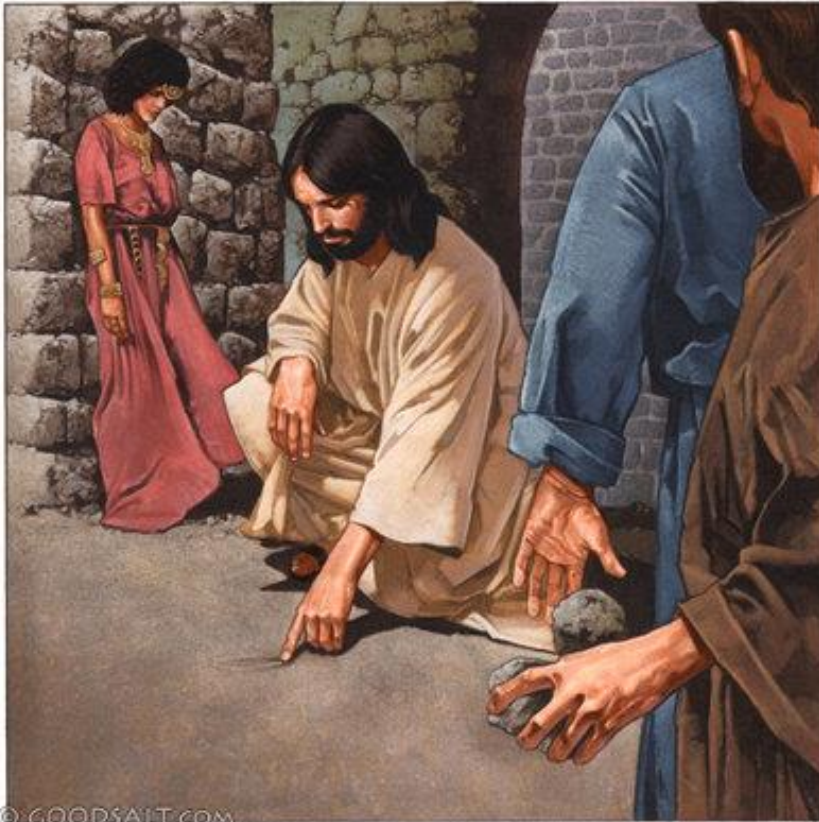

Fifth Sunday of Lent – Year C

March 13, 2016

Jesus bent down and began to write on the ground with his finger. he said to them, "Let the one among you who is without sin be the first to throw a stone at her."

A Gospel reflection from Fr. Alphonse:

Today's Gospel about the woman taken in adultery and dragged before Jesus contains minor and major features. For us to concentrate on how often we resemble the Pharisees in judging others can make us feel guilty for a moment, but it would be to miss the whole point of the choice of this Gospel for this Lenten Sunday.

The focus is on the sinful woman and what Jesus does for her. She is the one the Church wants us to identify with today and always. What feelings of terror, anger, fear, guilt and abandonment she must experience as she cringes in the midst of the hate-filled crowd! But there is One there who does not hate, who does not condemn, who understands human weakness and forgives. Everyone else condemns her, despises her, and she probably condemns and despises herself. But Jesus, instead of condemning, becomes her defender and wins her acquittal, and tells her to avoid sin.

Certainly, she obeys Jesus and avoids the sin, but she will never leave Him. What Jesus did for her was to restore her dignity, her self esteem. No one had ever believed in her before, so she could not believe in herself.

But Jesus believed in her. That's always the Way it is with Jesus and the Father. God's love and merciful forgiveness never degrades us as persons.

We welcome Fr. Charlie Vanwinkle as our celebrant at this weekend's Masses.

CATHOLIC CORNER: *A gentle reminder of what we learned but perhaps have forgotten or not thought about in a long time.*

The U.S. Catholic bishops call for all Catholics 14 years and older to **abstain** from meat on Good Friday. Good Friday ~ Catholics who are 18 to 59 years old are to **fast**. Fasting refers to the quantity of food eaten. Traditionally, fasting calls for refraining from eating between meals and consuming only one full meal per day. Some food which will not equal another full meal is permitted.

Praying the Way of the Cross as a devotion began in Jerusalem, with Christian pilgrims tracing the spots linked with the Passion and Death of Jesus. When travel to the Holy Land became difficult, churches began including fourteen stations on their walls where the faithful could make the "stations of the cross" spiritually. The devotion is intended to help Christ's followers join their own sufferings to His.
